## I. Biographical Sketch

Basil Manly Sr. (1798-1868) was an influential Southern Baptist pastor, educator, and missionary. Born in Pittsborough, North Carolina to Captain John Basil Manly and Elizabeth Maulsby, Manly received his education in South Carolina at Beauford College and South Carolina College. He married Sarah Murray Rudolph, the daughter of an Edgefield, South Carolina planter. Manly primarily conducted his ministry in South Carolina and Alabama. He pastored two prominent churches in Charleston, South Carolina: the First Baptist Church of Charleston from 1826 to 1837, and the Wentworth Street Baptist Church, 1855 to 1858. He was president of the University of Alabama from 1837 to 1855, he served as a missionary appointed by the Alabama Baptist Convention from 1858 until 1860, and he pastored the First Baptist Church of Montgomery, Alabama from 1860-1862. Manly was chaplain both to the Secession Convention of the State of Alabama and at the Inauguration of Jefferson Davis as President of the Confederate States of America. He was an instrumental figure in the formation of the Southern Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary; he served as the first president of the board of trustees for the latter institution. In 1867, Basil and Sarah Manly moved from Tuscaloosa, Alabama to Greenville, South Carolina to live with their son, Basil Manly Jr., who was a professor at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. Basil Manly Sr. died in Greenville on December 21, 1868.

## II. Scope and Content Note

The Basil Manly Sr. Papers comprises one linear foot and totals 481 items. The collection contains very little biographical information about Manly. It consists mainly of sermons, but it also contains letters and notebooks. This collection documents Manly's career as a pastor and will be most useful to researchers studying the Southern Baptist Convention, preaching in the South, and nineteenth century southern religion. Manly's "Sermons on Duty," and one folder of letters to Manly from Richard Fuller may be of particular interest. Researchers studying hymnology may find the collection useful because Manly often included references to specific hymnals and hymn numbers at the top of his sermons.

The collection contains four series. The first series consists of individual sermons arranged canonically. The second series contains several notebooks of sermons and other material. The third series consists of Manly's "Sermons on Duty," arranged by the sermon numbers that Manly used. The final series consists of letters and miscellaneous items. The majority of the sermons in this collection have been microfilmed. The Archives and Special Collections of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary has no information regarding how the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary obtained the Basil Manly Sr. Papers. Presumably, Basil Manly Jr. gave the collection to the seminary after his father's death in 1868.
